

# Hydracel Advanced Electrolyte Replacer for Horses



**INGREDIENTS:** Sodium 222g/kg, Chloride 485g/kg, Magnesium 17g/kg, Potassium 160g/kg, Palatinose™ 87g/kg, Betaine anhydrous 16g/kg

**DESCRIPTION:** **Hydracel** physiological electrolyte formula for horses is designed to replace essential electrolyte ions lost through sweat, encourage thirst/ fluid intake and optimise equine performance and recovery.

**PACK SIZE:** 2kg, 5kg, 15kg

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** Mix the required amount into feed daily per 500kg bodyweight. A 30g scoop is included.

*Light exercise*      30g (1 scoop)  
*Medium exercise*    60g (2 scoops)  
*Heavy exercise*      90g (3 scoops)

Alternatively, **Hydracel** can be dissolved into water at the rate of 45g per 25L of water.

Always ensure an adequate supply of clean, fresh drinking water is available at all times.

**SPECIAL FEATURES:** Unlike most traditional electrolyte replacers, **Hydracel** incorporates two additional unique ingredients: Betaine Anhydrous and Palatinose™.

Betaine is an osmolytic agent that works at a cellular level, and is also a component lost through sweat. The Hydracel formulation uses a natural form of Betaine, Betaine Anhydrous (not the synthetic form).

Palatinose is a natural energy source of functional carbohydrates that is hydrolysed to maximise digestibility, and provides a balanced release of energy, avoiding peaks and troughs.

**Hydracel** active formulation works to ensure that crucial cellular electrolyte homeostasis and correct fluid balance are maintained post recovery, after hard work and physical performance.
