


Optimum control of intestinal worms is achieved by adequate flea control and by daily disposal of droppings, where possible, as well as controlling intermediate hosts (including rats and mice). Flea tapeworms can reinfect cats and begin producing segments 2 - 3 weeks after treatment. If segments appear before the next scheduled dosing of the allwormer, re-treat. If worm problems persist, or if the infestation is heavy, consult a veterinarian.

• Do not administer to kittens under 6 weeks of age.


